wildlife, water and timber should be a focus of our District as the area continues to be assessed for ecological safety into the future. This is a bipartisan issue that we can find common ground

We support timber industry jobs that focus on sustainable practices, prioritize workers and meet the needs of our local communities. We need to make sure small forest owners are able to maintain their legacy of ownership of local forests.
